## National Energy Strategy

The Department of Energy (DOE) was directed by President Bush on July 26, 1989 to begin the development of a comprehensive National Energy Strategy (NES). Published in February 1991, the NES provides the foundation for a more efficient, less vulnerable, and environmentally sustainable energy future. The NES defines international, commercial, regulatory, and technological policy tools that diversify U.S. resources of energy supplies and offers more flexibility and efficiency in the way energy is transformed and used.

This proposed schedule provides for the disposition of records that have been created or received by DOE in connection with the development of the National Energy Strategy. In accordance with 36 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1228.28, the following information is provided for your review.

1. Records Series Title: National Energy Strategy
2. Description of Records: Documents which led to the development of the NES consists of subject files, letters, messages, memoranda, reports, handbooks, transcripts of public hearings, witnesses testimonies, and other documentary materials that detail the development of the NES.
3. Inclusive Dates: 1986-1993
4. Files Arrangement: The responsible program office arranged the records in alphabetical order by name, alphabetical order by subject, or chronological order. Each box contains a detailed listing of the documents contained therein.
