

1	<p><u>Oil Import Appeals Board (OIAB) Records.</u></p> <p>OIAB Case Files. Records consist of company requests for relief from hardship imposed by the Mandatory Oil Import Program. Included are hearing transcripts, correspondence, petitions, statistical summaries, and rulings. These records are arranged first by allocation period and thereunder by company name. They date from 1959 to 1975, were largely maintained by the Department of the Interior, and pre-date files created by the Federal Energy Administration and its successors. The records are contained in the WNRC accessions 434-73-0009, 434-74-0018, and 434-77-0116.</p> <p><u>Disposition:</u> Destroy when 15 years old.</p>		
2	<p>OIAB Company Files. These records are similar in content to those described above in item 1, but are arranged by company name. The files also were originally maintained by the Department of Commerce, which provided an OIAB member. The files date from 1956 to 1972 and pre-date files created by the Federal Energy Administration and its successors. The records are contained in WNRC accession 434-75-0004</p> <p><u>Disposition:</u> Destroy immediately.</p>
